IMPLANT SUPPORTED REMOVABLE PROSTHETICS: How to make it work!

(Full or Half-Day) - We can add a workshop to this as well.

Dental implants have revolutionized the replacement options that are available for complete and partial edentulism. A clear majority of our patients seek to augment the retention and stability of their dentures. Many times, this is the primary reason they come to us seeking dental implant solutions. However, there are a few limitations that one must be aware of and these can be described as structure and functional synergies. Another way to describe it is strategy and structural matches which must be observed to prevent failure. This seminar is designed primarily to discuss options for dental implants and removable prostheses and indications, relative contraindications, and absolute contraindications for these designs.

- 10 Structural Errors made which lead to failure.
- 3 Ways they can deal with failures.

CBCT USE FOR THE GENERAL DENTIST: How does this fit in my practice?

(Half-Day)

Cone Beam Computed Tomography has been around for over 20 years now and many practitioners ask if they need one. There are many presentations about the science and technology behind the CBCT but most leave you asking the question, how does this fit into my GP practice. The purpose of this presentation is to use cases to illustrate how CBCT can be used as an additional study to augment our clinical and radiographic exams and also how the imaging can be used with other forms of technology to create better outcomes from a treatment planning point of view. From basic Implant Planning, assessment of Teeth & Periodontal Structures, assessment of Impacted Teeth, evaluation of Trauma, Sleep Apnea, Cysts/Tumours Endodontic lesions, TMJ Evaluation & Paranasal Sinuses.

The participants will learn:

10 Disciplines and Sub-Disciplines in dentistry that CBCT can improve.

3 Ways to use CBCT images to improve treatment planning.

5 Ways to use CBCT images to increase case acceptance.

HEMATOLOGY, BLOODWORK & How to use it in Dentistry.

(Half-Day) - we can add a workshop to this as well.

Blood tests have been used in modern medicine for a long time. They help guide many diagnosis and monitoring of treatment for the modern physician. In the past dentistry had perhaps a more mechanical focus and in recent times with greater use of surgery in our practices and better types of biomedical engineering options, blood work can be of great benefit to the dentist to guide diagnosis and monitoring of treatment for our patients which leads to better outcomes. Areas we focus on are Diabetes, Bone Healing, Bleeding, Liver Function, Kidney Function, B12/Folate Deficiency, Calcium, Phosphorus, Magnesium Deficiency, Infectious Diseases & Parasites.

- 5 Blood Tests that improve oral health outcomes.
- 2 Ways to improve communication with physicians.
- 2 Ways to venipuncture in your own office.



IMPLANT CONSENT, PAPERWORK & FOLLOW-UP: THE DIRTY JOBS!

The introduction of implants into your dental practice can have a tremendous affect on your bottom line or it can become your worst nightmare. Many patients who seek dental implant therapy present with various “ideas” of what dental implants mean to them and the costs, both short & long term, which are associated with them. This presentation will provide you with frameworks & documents which you can use in your oral health education processes in practice to ensure that there is a shared meaning with your patients and ensure that you are satisfied with the consent process and the documents which are efficiently generated in office. Surprises are never a good thing in implant dentistry and having effective communication can be the difference between a satisfied & knowledgeable patient OR a nightmare!

DIGITAL V. ANALOG DENTISTRY: REALITY VERSUS FICTION!

The introduction of digital dentistry was a welcome addition to the traditional workflows which we had been using for decades in dental practice. Things like digital smile design, photography, intraoral scanning and CBCT, along with 3D printing and milling, have changed many of the workflows which we use in practice. However, there is a misconception that digital is better, There is also a misconception about what being totally digital really means. There is a still a time and place for using traditional analog methods which when used in synergy can lead to outstanding patient outcomes. The presentation uses cases to highlight many of these points.

- 4 Things which digital dentistry will replace in the conventional analog work flow.
- 5 Advantages which digital dentistry has over analog dentistry.
- 3 Misconceptions everyone has about digital dentistry.



LAB TO DENTIST COMMUNICATION: How to tame the CATS!

This presentation is geared towards the entire dental treatment team. The end goal is happy outcomes for the patient, end point! The blame game is too late for the patient, and in a sense this a failure of the entire team. Communication can help eliminate bad outcomes and this presentation is all about how this can be done well, efficiently and most important with outcomes in mind.

Topics covered in the lecture segment include; Dental Implant History, Simple Treatment Planning, The Surgical Phase, The Prosthetic Phase, Long-Term Follow-Up & Maintenance, Management of Complications & Recordkeeping. The workshop is intended to allow the participants to place a dental implant in a plastic jaw model and then go over the prosthetic techniques to restore a dental implant.

Platelet Rich Fibrin: Regeneration options for Hair, Facial Esthetics & Surgery

(Full Day; including the hands-on workshop)

What is PRF (Platelet Rich Fibrin); A matrix concentrate of autologous platelets, leukocytes, and fibrin. Gain predictable regeneration and accelerated healing for an overall increase of treatment success with our course in PRF applications to various implant surgical procedures, hair and skin improvements. Platelet-rich fibrin is a second-generation platelet concentrate which can enhance both soft and hard tissue healing. Its advantages over platelet-rich plasma include ease of preparation, ease of application, minimal expense, and lack of biochemical modification (no bovine thrombin or anticoagulant is required). This considerably reduces the biochemical handling of blood as well as risks associated with the use of bovine derived thrombin. PRF also contains physiologically available thrombin that results in slow polymerization of fibrinogen into fibrin which results in a physiologic architecture that is favorable to wound healing and promoting regen.

- Predictable grafting.
- Subjectively less pain.

Oral Surgery for the General Practitioner: How to make it FLOW better in your clinic.

(Half Day or Full Day) - we can add a workshop to this as well.

This presentation is to discuss & demonstrate oral surgical procedures that can be performed by the GP safely in office with ease and confidence. I will discuss my own journey in this discipline and go over tips, tricks and mentorship I have gained in my 20+ year career as a wet-fingered GP. We will use a combination of cases with photos, videos, CBCT, radiographs and history & physical exam data to learn how to extract teeth, raise flaps, place implants and grafts, suture well, draw blood for PRF, interpret blood tests, perform biopsies, expose teeth for orthodontics and do frenectomies.

The participants will learn:

1. How to extract teeth, both erupted and impacted with confidence.
2. How to venipuncture a patient to draw blood to make PRF in your office.
3. How to use blood tests to augment the surgical outcomes for your patients.
4. How to perform various surgical procedures in office like frenectomies, biopsy and ortho exposures.
5. How to deal with complications and post-op infections and manage your surgical patients.
